2019 Enhanced Learning Mini-Grant Program

Rules and Guidelines

- Individual teachers or teams of teachers in the Surry County Schools System may apply for grants up to \$750. *\*\*Judges have the discretion to award additional funding if the project calls for funding over \$750. Proof of other funding sources that support the project must be provided.*
- Only one application per educator or team of educators will be accepted per year.
- Grants will not be awarded for educator's salaries, staff development for educators, field trips, or transportation. Only requests for tools that will increase student engagement outside of regular funding will be accepted.
- Grant selection is anonymous.
- Grant Application Deadline: March 29, 2019 by 5 pm
- All teachers/teams receiving a mini-grant are required to submit a comprehensive grant follow-up report by the end of the project or no later than May 31, 2020. A follow up report form will be sent to each recipient upon announcement of awarded mini-grants.

Project requirements:

- Directly involve and benefit students, enhance student learning
- Support the overall goals of the classroom, not curriculum related
- Support STEM education, reading achievement goals, and/or the arts
- Be creative and innovative
- Be completed in the 2019-2020 school year
- Be replicable by other teachers
- Have no other funding sources

How to Apply

- Complete grant cover sheet
- **Do not mention your name or name of school in actual proposal or grant name.**
- Type your proposal using parameters established.
- Sign and date the cover sheet. In addition, your principal should sign and date.
- Do not add supplemental materials or additional documentation.
