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| 1 | Has your child had close contact (within 6 feet of someone diagnosed with COVID-19 for a cumulative total of 15 minutes over a 24-hour period) in the last 14 days, or has any health department or health care provider been in contact with you and advised you to quarantine? | <p>NO - Child can go to school today</p> <p>YES - Child CANNOT go to school today.</p> <p><i>See guidance below about return to school or follow directions from a health care provider.</i></p> |
| 2 | Does your child or any household member have any of these symptoms? - Fever (100.4° F or higher) - Chills - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing - New Cough - New loss of taste or smell | <p>NO - Child can go to school today</p> <p>YES - Child and siblings CANNOT go to school today.</p> <p>Seek medical assistance for your child.</p> <p><i>See guidance below about return to school or follow directions from a health care provider.</i></p> |

If my child has been out of school due to a previous "YES" response above, when can my child return to school?

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| 1 | Child remains at home for 14 days from the date of exposure to COVID-19 positive person. |
| 2 | If a child had a negative COVID-19 test, they can return to school once there is no fever without the use of fever-reducing medicine and they have felt well for 24 hours. |
| | If confirmed positive COVID-19 test or if the child has not been tested, they can return to school 10 days after they first had symptoms, have no fever for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medicine and they have symptom improvement including no cough and no shortness of breath. |
| | Household members (e.g., siblings) should also quarantine for 14 days from last exposure unless the symptomatic person is cleared as a result of a negative test for COVID-19. |
| | If a confirmed diagnosis other than COVID-19 (e.g. stomach virus, ear infection, etc.), follow normal school policies for returning to school. |
| 3 | If a child has been diagnosed with COVID-19, but does not have symptoms, they should remain out of school until 10 days have passed since the date of their first positive COVID-19 diagnostic test. |
